Dear Parents

Thank you so much for entrusting your child to our care on Sunday mornings. We look forward to a terrific time of fun and learning as we study the Bible together in lots of interesting ways.

Sign In Book

Sunday school begins after the worship service in church; however we would appreciate it if you would sign your child in prior to the start of the worship service. The sign in book is in the kitchen on the bench. Once church is finished, children can be collected from Sunday school and signed out. Signing in and out must be done by an authorised adult.

Blue Cards

All our teachers and assistants hold Blue Cards permitting them to work with children. For this reason we allow no-one other than Blue Card holders approved by the Pastor to be in attendance at Sunday school. This ensures the safety of every child.

Children of all ages are capable of understanding quite a lot about the Bible and how it relates to their daily lives. Each week we make every effort not only to study the Bible story, but also to relate it to real-life applications that the children can put to practical use in their spiritual journey.

Sunday school affirms the home as the centre of biblical guidance. Parents are the most important people in a child's life, and learning about God starts in the home. Teaching children about God is a seven-day-a-week effort, not something that can be done just in an hour on Sunday morning. We will do our best to support you in your child's spiritual education, and are ready to help you at any time.

Morning Tea and Food

We supply sandwiches, cordial and water for morning tea. Please let us know if your child has any allergies or other dietary restrictions by completing the enrolment form and giving it to the Sunday School Superintendent. Because of this and out of fairness to other children, we ask that your child not bring food or drink into Sunday school. For the same reason, we also ask that you not send cakes for your child's birthday.

Some of the things you can do to support Sunday School are:

Encourage Regular Attendance

Church starts each week at 10:00 a.m. Please ensure your child is on time and attends as often as possible. Consistency and continuity are extremely important for your child during these years. To provide the best learning experience, we teach in units of study that build from week to week, and it's best for the child to be able to experience each week's lesson. We prepare carefully each week to begin meaningful teaching from the very beginning of the class, and your child's arrival on time helps the whole class to get the most out of the session.

Bring Bible and Offering

Please encourage your child to bring a Bible and an offering each week. We will use the Bible each Sunday in the class for older children but bringing a Bible each week to church, even for the younger children is a great habit for them to develop. We use the children's offering to help them develop good habits of stewardship.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Pray

We promise to join you in praying for you and your child. We believe that prayer is an effective and powerful force to help protect your child and help him develop to his highest spiritual potential. We would appreciate your prayers for us and the Sunday school as well.

Bible Reading & Memory Verse

We use New King James and Contemporary English versions of the Bible and encourage the children to read the Bible every day. A verse of scripture is given each week for the children to memorise and we would appreciate your assistance in helping them to learn their verse each week.
